4. Academic Information

English Course

We offer English courses over various departments. Exchange students are allowed to take courses from different departments **<u>upon availability</u>**. The most up-to-date course list becomes available a month prior to the beginning of semester. Until then, student can refer to the previous year's course list. (e.g. 2019 fall semester applicant can refer to 2018 fall semester course list. Previous English course list and information on how to find the syllabus can be found on our <u>website</u>.

Korean Language Course

Two types of Korean language courses are offered to exchange students during their study period at Hanyang; Introductory Korean Language Course (called Survival Korean) and Intensive Korean Language Course. The number of session students can take differs according to their study period:

1 semester	Max. 1 session (during semester)	Max. 1 session (during semester)
2 semesters	Max. 2 sessions (2 during semester)	Max. 3 sessions (2 during semesters, 1 during vacation)

Students are responsible for paying fees associated with additional course. Special arrangement will be made according to the agreement between their home university and Hanyang.

Credits and Study Load

Hanyang 1 credit consists of 15 contact hours. Usually, students at Hanyang takes 15~18 credits per semester and students can get maximum 20 credits. Exchange students should take at least one regular course (2 or 3 credits) to maintain their visa.

Course Registration

Before coming to Korea, students will have a chance to register courses online. There are different phases for course registration categorized by their major and year and it works on "first-come, first-served" basis. The specific dates will be sent to students directly through email.

Evaluation and Grade

Although the evaluation method may differ based on professor's policy, attendance is always an essential part of the evaluation process. Hanyang does not have re-sit examinations so the final grade inputted into the system cannot be changed. Students can take only one P/F course in one semester and most courses will be in letter grade. Please refer to the below chart for the grade system at Hanyang.

Academic Transcript

Official academic transcript will be issued one month after the last day of each semester and sent to student's home university. Transcripts include two copies of regular courses and one copy of Introductory/Intensive Korean language course.

5. Campus Life

Housing

Students can apply for Hanyang's on-campus dormitory and the application will be done separately approximately 2 months before the semester begins. Application works on "first-come, first-served" basis and special arrangement can be made for scholarship recipients upon availability.

Buddy Program

Buddies are current Hanyang students who volunteer to support new students for their smooth settlement and adjustment into the life and culture in Korea. Upon arrival, buddies will interact with new exchange/visiting students throughout the semester and provide them with assistance in various areas. Students can apply for this program by uploading an <u>application</u> form when filling out the online application.
